INVESTING IN SKILLS - A SUGGESTION BY THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL

13 March 2014

How can qualifications in Europe can be improved in order to increase the employability of young people? The Ministers of the Council of EU was faced with this question after the last results of the PISA Study were published.

Member States need to develop effective policies and invest even more in an efficient education and training.

At their meeting on 24 February 2014 in Brussels the EU ministers of education stressed that education and training systems should play a fundamental role when it comes to ensuring that young people and low-skilled adults acquire qualifications and competences **matching today's labor market**. These conclusions are a first response to the results of the last two OECD studies, and to what emerged in the Annual Growth Survey 2014.
